# DUNN PAL

Dunn PAL was first started in 1995 as a Juvenile Crime Prevention Program of the Dunn Police Department under Community Policing. PAL is Police Officers and citizens working with youth to keep them off of the streets and out of trouble in various athletic and educational programs.

The Harnett County School Board saw the need for PAL and more after-school activities so they leased the property that PAL is on to the City of Dunn to help Dunn PAL.

A grant was originally received from the Governor's Crime Commission to start PAL. PAL was started in the spring of 1995 with 10 youth playing softball and has since grown to over 350 youth yearly participating at the PAL Center in various activities.

Several activities operate out of the PAL Center, but there are several activities that are operated at schools facilities and City Parks. Dunn PAL is operated as a Community Center to house activities during the week after school for youth. The Center is usually open five days a week and some Saturdays.

There is currently a learning center where computers, books and other materials are located so youth can

learn. Dunn PAL offers after-school tutoring and Support Our Student Education Programs. Dunn PAL also has partnered with Healthy Choices to further expand life skills. Dunn PAL is a chartered member of National PAL, NC PALS, Amateur Athletic Union (AAU), USA Boxing, USSSA, YBOA, Track and Field and other organizations.
